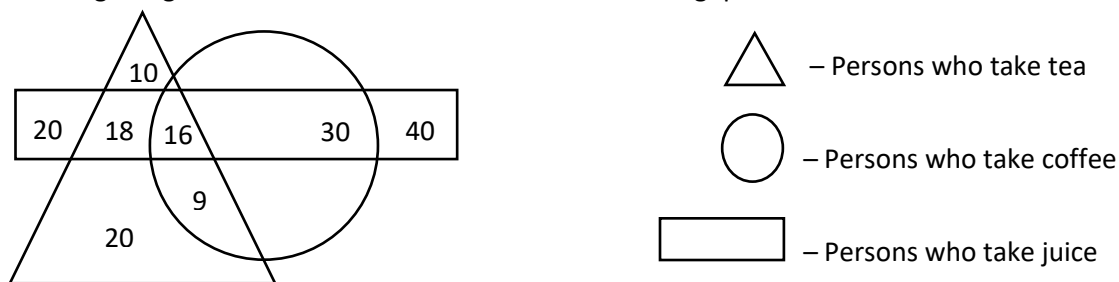

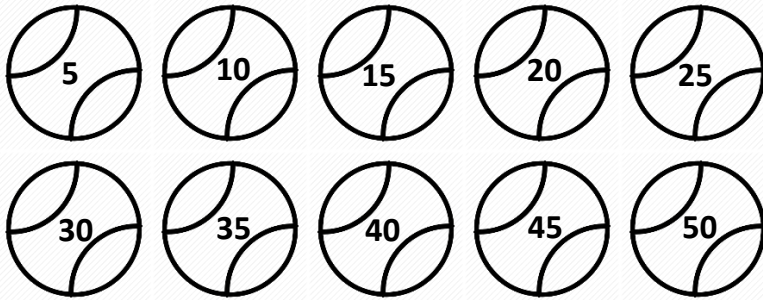
- Study the diagram given below and answer each of the following questions:
