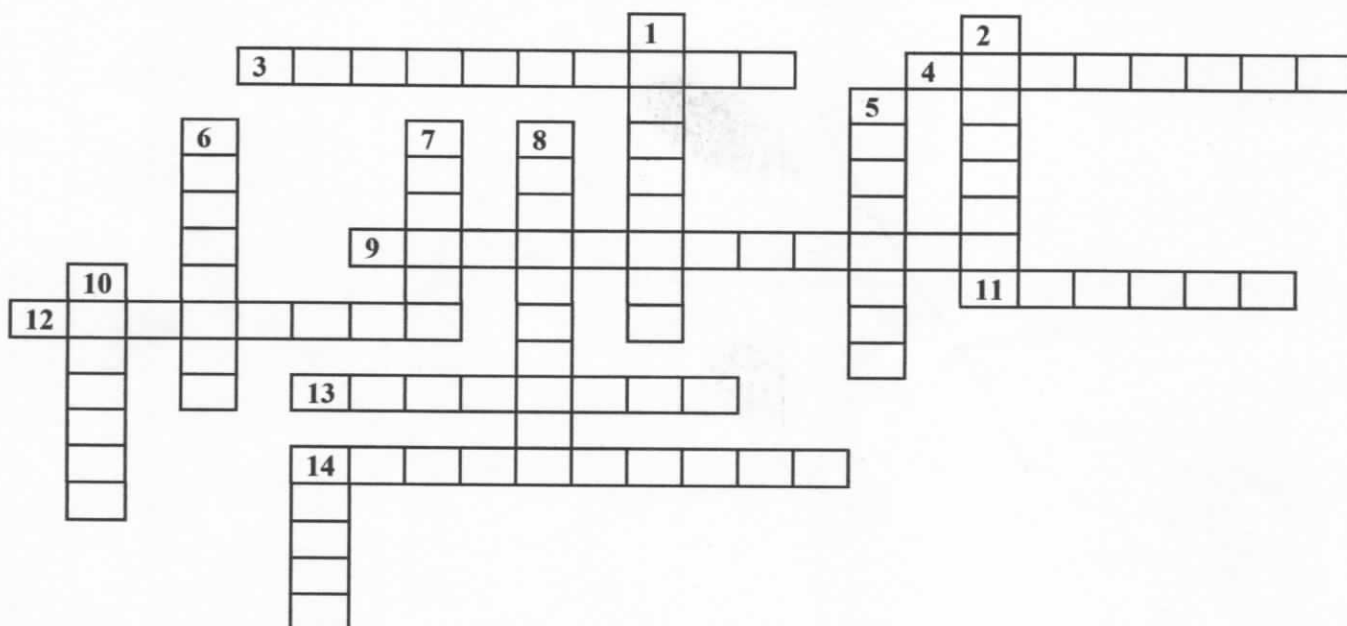
1. Summer vacation will begin from **11th May, 2019 (Saturday)**.

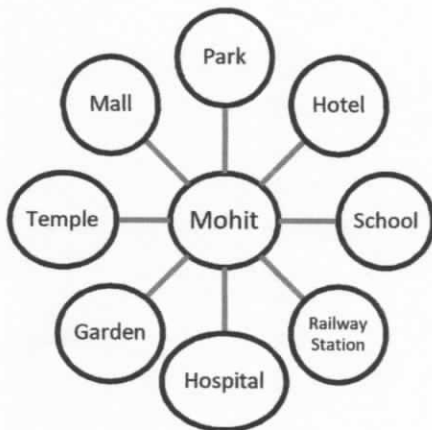
