7. Describe this picture .Give names to all the kids and their dog. Use your imagination and write what they are talking about. Also write what the dog might be thinking about.

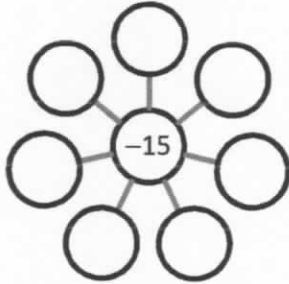


8. Develop a paragraph from the hints given below:
