# SCHOOL MANAGING COMMITTEE (SMC) **DECISIONS**

With the schools being closed due to the pandemic, the following important decisions were taken by the SMC members regarding functioning and strategy required during this special period.

1. It was decided that the school will conduct virtual classes for all students. The paid version of Zoom classes was chosen for better safety standard.
2. The teachers are required to be trained and adapted to the new technology required to take the classes and it was decided that the tech and computer department will ensure that all teachers get the basic training to operate virtual classes.
3. It was decided to call the staff in school in roster as per the guidelines of the government released from time to time and strictly follow.
4. For the fee issue, as the petition is put before the High Court, till the decision is given, the school will only charge tuition fee and no other charges in any head will be taken. Further relaxation can be made in exceptional cases of financial difficulties faced by the parents.
5. The decision was taken to regularly apprise the parents about the ward's attendance and performance and therefore, Virtual Parent's meet has to be organized.
6. Special emphasis was put by the members on the need of regular training and up gradation of the teachers. It was decided to enroll our teachers in the Virtual Trainings organized by CBSE and also by other certified trainers.
7. The committee members decided to approve the construction of new building for more rooms required for the senior secondary classes. Approval was also given for renovation of Computer lab and Library along with the construction of Rest rooms in Senior Wing building.
8. The members allowed the teachers to take virtual classes from their homes by providing any technical support like laptops or systems till condition become conducive for them to be called to the school.





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
